From the office or wherever they are, managers can login to request check-ins, view reports, issue notifications and monitor the ongoing safety of their operations.

Under Workplace Health and Safety legislation, management are responsible if workers are at risk, whether they are in the office, on a remote site, in transit or working from home. This has become a prominent issue for companies when it comes to ensuring staff safety and accountability when employees are working off-site.
