Aeeris will provide its *Early Warning Network* (EWN) services, which will be used to improve the safety of its employees and reduce the risk to the organisation Australia-wide.

This is another national project for the Company, in addition to the agreement announced recently with a leading ASX listed property group.

Services and benefits

As part of the agreement Aeeris' *Geospatial Notification Information System* (GNIS) will provide a set of alerting, forecasting and monitoring tools as part of the EWN offering, which will be integrated seamlessly across a number of divisions including the organisation's National Service Operations Centre, Field Operations and Business Continuity and Disaster Response units.

The tools will enable the customer to track risks such as severe weather events, flooding, bushfires, temperature inversions and power outages.

The organisation will benefit from the EWN's unique 24/7, 365 days per year Alert Operator monitoring capability, which is backed by many years of collective meteorological and hazard observation experience.

The customer is building an infrastructure project on a very large scale, and is seeking to use Aeeris services to protect employees and contractors, many of whom are in the field.

As such the services that Aeeris provides will enable the organisation to not only protect its workers, contractors and assets by enhancing internal health & safety and asset management capability, but will also allow the customer to increase the efficiency of its work force and monitor the optimal time to commence work in remote areas.
